
U.S. Office of Personnel Management Data Center Consolidation Roadmap

Chandler, Arizona

Closed in October 2016.

Ashburn, Virginia

Closed in January.

Denver, Colorado (IBC)

- 1. Build development, test, and production infrastructure: January to April
- 2. Conduct testing and validation: March to May
- 3. Move systems to Boyers and Macon data centers: May
- 4. Migrate and sync data and test configurations: May to August
- 5. Relocate to Macon: June
- 6. Relocate to Boyers: July
- 7. Decommission IBC Systems: July to September

Fort Meade, Maryland

- 1. Plan infrastructure services and NBIB application migration: January to April
- 2. Conduct capacity planning and stage services in Macon: February to June
- 3. Validate migration plan: March to May
- 4. Move systems to Macon and DC and conduct testing: June
- 5. Relocate to Macon: June
- 6. Decommission Fort Meade systems: June

Sterling, New York

- 1. Conduct Analysis of Alternatives: April to July
- 2. Conduct application inventory and validate migration plan: June to October
- 3. Decommission redundant capacity: November

Washington, DC

Theodore Roosevelt Building Mainframe

- 1. Conduct Analysis of Alternatives: February to August
- 2. Conduct application inventory and validate migration plan: May to after December
- 3. Pilot applications, sync data, and test configurations: August to after December
- 4. Execute transition: October to after December

Theodore Roosevelt Building Computing Center

- 1. Conduct data center survey and confirm services: April to September
- 2. Establish migration plan: August to December
- 3. Capture hardware and software inventory and confirm asset management processes: September to after December
- 4. Execute transition: October to after December

Boyers, Pennsylvania

Core data center; will not close.

Macon, Georgia

Core data center; will not close.
